Also, the fittesting machine does not disinfect, it only tests the fit of masks; seconded by Schmidt. Roll call: Patterson-aye, Schmidt-aye, Horner-aye. Motion passes.

Fiscal Officer Report

- Payment Listing- totals \$22,596.17 (See Attached).
 - Trustee Schmidt questioned the payments to Vision Services. This is the reimbursement from Chief Fletcher back to WFRD.
 - Trustee Schmidt questioned the payments to Fallsway. This is for the annual service on two tankers (162-1 and 161-1). Other issues were found when the annual service was being done and repairs are being done.
 - Trustee Horner questioned the large payment amount to the contracted mowing company. The contracted mowing has been done weekly, for a total of seven times, thus far. This is the first invoice WFRD has received from Followay Lawn Care thus far.
