

**8/5/2024**

Patterson called the Westfield Township Fire and Rescue Meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Role Call: Schmidt, Horner, Patterson

Others in attendance: Chief Hall

No comments from the floor.

A representative from Congressman Max Miller's office dropped off pamphlets around the resource guides available for us to handout. The trustees thanked them for their dedication to the district. They asked if they would look at the levy to see if they were interested in possibly endorsing the levy for the Westfield Township Fire and Rescue District.

No minutes will be approved at this meeting.

Chief Hall provided an update: 51 calls, including mutual aid to Lafayette, Seville, the Village and Lodi. Provided update on billing. 27 total transports by EMS. 35 calls during the day and 16 at night. Mutual aid received 3 times.

\$34,435.83 and \$10,063.20 sent out in EMS Billing and MVA/Fire.

No missed calls.

2 angle grinders were donated by Black and Decker.

Chief Hall and Assistant Chief Young attended development training. This counted as 12 hours of leadership training.

167-1 sent back to be repaired because of multiple oil leaks. Quote to fix was \$2,220.15. Final invoice has not yet been received.

167-2 had a flat tire. Bob Sumeral Tire plugged the tire at no charge. The fire department thanks them!

Medina County Health Dept 8/19 would like to use a bay at the fire department for Back to School review for the area.

Gov Deals is not working to sell the extra, dated equipment at the fire department. Chief would like to donate those tools to the Medina County Career Center. Chief believes the value of these older tools combined might be around \$2,000. If donated these tools would be used for adult education at the Career Center. This donation would only be for a TNT hydraulic rescue set.

Patterson makes a motion to donate the TNT hydraulic rescue set on behalf of the Westfield Fire and Rescue District. Schmidt seconds the motion. **Role call- Schmidt- yes, Patterson- yes, Horner- yes. Motion passed.**

No updates on grants.


